

# Bicycle, Pedestrian and Traffic Safety Tips



## SAFE DRIVING PRACTICES

### DO:

- Pull up all the way to Pick-Up and Drop-Off students
- Stop in advance of the marked crosswalks and yield right of way to all pedestrians
- Park safely along curbs and in parking lots
- Enter the school driveway in a single file line
- Obey 25 mile per hour speed limit

## DANGEROUS DRIVING PRACTICES

### DON'T:

- Drop students off at the beginning of the driveway, causing more congestion (Pull Forward all the way to the gym)
- Park on top of crosswalks or immediately in front of crosswalks and block pedestrian access to crosswalks
- Park along Red Curbs or Double-Park
- Cut in front of the line waiting to enter the school driveway
- Talk or text on your cell phone

## SAFE PEDESTRIAN AND BICYCLE PRACTICES

### DO:

- Wear your Helmet
- Look both ways before crossing
- Cross only in marked crosswalks
- Get off your bike when crossing the street
- Watch for turning cars at street corners
- Obey stop signs and stop lights when riding your bike
- Be visible and alert!

## DANGEROUS PEDESTRIAN AND BICYCLE PRACTICES

### DON'T:

- Run across street
- Run between cars
- Cut the corner
- Don't J-walk
- Don't cross the street when the signal has a flashing "RED" hand
- Step off the sidewalk when waiting for parents or waiting to cross the street
