



## IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

### FOLLOW THESE BEST PRACTICES TO **arrive safely!**

#### PEDESTRIAN SAFETY

Our community is a pedestrian-friendly city, with ample trails and sidewalks lining most streets. While walking may be simple, it's important to learn and know the basics of walking safely around crosswalks, in parking lots, and elsewhere around town.

**Always cross at an intersection** and in a crosswalk.

**Make eye contact** with drivers to be sure you are seen.

**Always look** left, right and left **again**, before crossing.

**Avoid** wearing headphones or using your phone when crossing the street.

**Watch** for traffic the entire time you are crossing a street.

**Be aware** of turning vehicles.

**Do not** cross in the middle of the street or cross from between parked cars.

**Avoid** walking in traffic where there are no sidewalks or crosswalks wherever possible.

**If** you do have to walk along a road without sidewalks, be sure to walk **facing** traffic.

**Watch for cars** entering or exiting driveways, or backing up in parking lots.

**Wear** bright colors or reflective clothing if walking at night. Consider carrying a flashlight.

**Do not** start crossing the intersection if you see a flashing.

#### BICYCLE SAFETY

The City of San Ramon is a great place to ride. Our neighborhoods and the accessibility of the Iron Horse Trail and other trails make bike riding to school fun. Whether you are a child or adult, it is important to know basic bicycle safety principles before you start your ride.

**Wear** a properly fitted helmet.

**Ride** with the flow of traffic.

**Slow down and yield** (give up your right of way) to pedestrians.

**Cross only** at marked crosswalks and walk your bike across the crosswalk.

**Stop and look** left, right and left **again**, before crossing.

**Do not wear headphones** or ear buds while riding.

**Wear** bright clothing or reflective gear.

**Use hand signals** (directional).

**Ride single file**, with one space between **each** bike, when riding with a group.

**Ring your bicycle bell before** passing on the left.

### TAKE NOTE!

The location of traffic control devices and roadway conditions may change. As such, parents and guardians should regularly review the route with their children.

**Crossing Guards** are located along suggested routes to guide pedestrians; however, pedestrians should always follow road rules and cross with caution.

### TRAVEL SAFELY WITH THESE ROAD RULES:

**Don't Assume the Driver Sees You.** Always make eye contact before crossing the street.

**Be Predictable.** Obey **all** traffic signals, and signs. If there is a flashing crosswalk or traffic signal, remember to push the button and wait your turn.

**Be Alert.** Stop and look for cars in **all** directions before crossing the street.

**Cross at Corners and Marked Crosswalks.** This is where drivers expect pedestrians. Don't run across the middle of the road.

**Wear Your Helmet.** It's the law if you are under 18. To protect your brain, the helmet must fit properly, snug, and just above your eyebrows.
