Most students opting to come back are struggling academically with remote, some are English learners. Majority will be remote. There will be schedule changes and new teachers will be assigned, due by tomorrow. Parents will be notified by Monday 2 pm.

Discussions around effective asynchronous learning, building communities in school. Hybrid is a mix of students from different classes. Efforts to make students feel part of the community and ease the transition.

Plan is to open as planned and the school will make changes to the schedule. If the reopening date does move, students will still continue with the new teacher and new schedule.
